A Brief History of Our Company

The Stephenson Funeral Home was established in 1949 by Carl R. Stephenson, who purchased the stately Goodman home on McEwan Street. This home, built in 1891 by banker and hardware dealer William H. Goodman, was restored to its former elegance by Carl and Virginia Stephenson. A large chapel was added to the original structure in 1967. The firm merged in 1968 with the Doherty Funeral Home, a firm established over 75 years before.

On September 1, 1975, the Stephenson-Doherty Funeral Home was purchased by Lawrence D. Wyman Sr., and in 1976 became known as the Stephenson-Wyman Funeral Home. Lawrence Jr. joined his father as a licensed mortician in 1979. In 1998 Lawrence Jr. purchased the Funeral Home from his father.

In 2005 property was acquired in the Village of Farwell, and construction began on the new Stephenson-Wyman Funeral Home, Farwell Chapel. The new chapel sits upon land once occupied by the Farwell Railroad Depot, and opened the summer of 2006. Today our family continues the tradition of service to families in the greater Clare, Farwell, Lake and Lake George area's.
