Jerry Lee Allen, age 66 of Clare, passed away peacefully at his home on Saturday, March 11, 2017 with his family by his side. Jerry was born the son of Claude and Maxine (Savercool) Allen on June 7, 1950 in Harrison, MI. On September 13, 1975 he was united in marriage to Karen Vought, his wife of 41 years. Jerry was a man of many passions. He was an avid painter, a nature lover, a WWI and WWII history buff, and he knew everything about any airplane ever constructed. His love for airplanes was recently honored with an award of excellence and key to the city of Clare for his outstanding contributions as an original member of the Clare Municipal Airport Advisory Board. Jerry was also a proud Veteran of the US Army (having served during the Vietnam Era), a proud graduate of Central Michigan University, and most importantly, the proud co-owner and operator of the Wee Care Child Care & Preschool, Inc. of Clare. Alongside his wife Karen, the couple has touched hundreds of lives since opening in 1989.

Jerry is survived by his wife Karen, his mother Maxine Allen of Mt. Pleasant, and four siblings Vernon Allen of Flint, Penny (Patrick) Nowak of Ohio, Rusty (Barbara) Allen of Flint, and Lee Allen of Mt. Pleasant. Other survivors include Jerry's nieces Cheryl Allen, and Rylee and Kali Lapham, best friends Ron and Linda Smades, and "adopted" kids Lee and Laura Cater and Katie and Zach Simon. Jerry was predeceased by his father Claude and his sister-in-law Barbara Allen.
