Robert (Bob) Thomas Ohler, age 81 of Farwell, passed away Saturday, January 19, 2019 at his home. Bob was born the son of Thomas and Nellie (Giammaria) Ohler on January 20, 1937 in Greensburg, PA. Bob served his Country in the U. S. Marine Corps. He was honorably discharged in 1963 after serving two years of active service and five years in the reserves. Bob enjoyed hunting in Clare and moved his family from St Clair Shores to Clare in 1972. He then started a refuse hauling company.
