Albert "Al" J. Cruden, age 77 of Clare, passed away following an extended illness on Friday, October 3, 2025 surrounded by his loving family at home. Al was born the son of the late Andrew and Irene (Speakman) Cruden on December 20, 1947 in Detroit. He and his family had moved to Clare when he was younger, and Al graduated from Clare High School.
