Albert P. Galler Jr., age 80, of Clare, died suddenly at home on Saturday, July 28. He was born the son of Albert and Rose (Giovanni) Galler on Sept. 7, 1931, in Pontiac. Albert was a self employed farmer operating the Galler Farms with his sons and had also been a Dozer operator with the State Highway Department for a time. He and Rose moved to Clare 45 years ago from Armada, Michigan. He had been a member of the Farm Bureau and had attended the St. Henry's and St. Cecilia Catholic Churches.
