Allan "Al" Roy Davis, age 78 of Clare, passed away Sunday, May 4, 2025, at his home. Al was born the son of Albert and Marion (Parkinson) Davis on March 4, 1947, in Detroit. He was united in marriage to the love of his life Vivian Carol Wooten on August 6, 1966, in New Buffalo, Michigan with her predeceasing him on October 28, 2017. Al had served his country in the U.S. Air Force as a Crew Chief and jet engine mechanic in the Vietnam War. Al and Vivian moved to Clare in 1983 from the Ann Arbor/Tecumseh area. 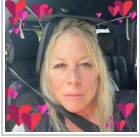
