Alvin Lawrence Wichert, age 71 of Farwell, passed away Thursday, January 2, 2020. Alvin was born the son of the late Edwin F. and Effie M. (Hafner) Wichert on May 8, 1948 in Loomis. He had worked at MMI in Mt. Pleasant starting in April of 1984 until 2017 before transferring to MMI in Clare working there to the present. In 1959 Alvin had been the poster child of the Isabella Chapter, Michigan Society for Crippled Children and Adult, Inc. In his younger years he had attended the Trinity United Methodist Church in Mt. Pleasant. He loved classic cars and Batman; his CB handle was BATMAN.
