Benjamin D. Walters, age 47, of Clare passed away suddenly on Sunday, August 3, 2014. Ben was a life resident of the Clare area and was employed by AT&T as a Telecom Technician. His community meant a lot to him. He had been a paramedic with the Clare County EMS, Gratiot County EMS, and with Mobile Medical Response for several years and had served as a Reserve Police officer for Clare P.D. He had been a member of the Clare Kiwanis Club, had coached several Girls Softball teams when his daughters had been involved, Big Brothers and Sisters, and was currently serving on the Clare City Planning Commission.
