



Beverly "Jackie" J. Randle

Beverly "Jackie" J. Randle, age 82 of Clare, passed away Sunday, November 19, 2017 at the MidMichigan Medical Center in Clare. Jackie was born the daughter of the late Otis and Geneva (Davis) McPhall on June 23, 1935 in Surrey Township. She had lived in the Clare area her entire life and was a decedent of one of the first pioneer settlers of the area. She had attended schools in Clare and Gladwin. She was united in marriage to Robert L. Randle on July 21, 1951 in Clare with him predeceasing her on May 20, 2008. Beverly had worked at Schaeffers Restaurant, the Fuller Department Store and Holly Carburetor before attending Delta College, earning her certificate as a Physical Therapy Aide; she had worked for the Gladwin Hospital for three and a half years and then the Clare Hospital for thirty three years. Beverly was an avid outdoorsman who enjoyed deer hunting, fishing and snowmobiling when she was younger. She also enjoyed cooking, canning and quilting. Her faith was important to her; she was an active member of the Church of Daniel's Band. Beverly will be remembered as being a loving wife, mother and grandmother who enjoyed spending time with her family and being a jokester. Jackie is survived by her daughters Regina (Lee) Agle of Clare, Linda (Greg) Yuncker of Kalkaska, Pam (Rod) Lippold of Clare and Mary Jo (Andy) Gross of Coleman; 11 grandchildren and 14 great grandchildren. 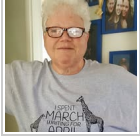
