Brenda Marie Campbell-VanDenBosch, 62, passed away unexpectedly at her home in Farwell, Michigan, on December 3, 2025. She was born on September 7, 1963, in Lakeview, Michigan. 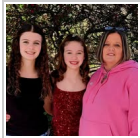

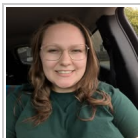
