Calvin "Cal" F. Foss, age 90 of Clare, passed away Tuesday, November 18, 2014 at LifeHOUSE Prestige Place in Clare. Cal was born the son of the late Ernest and Hazel (Brown) Foss on November 29, 1923 in Clare. He was united in marriage to Doris Zinser on April 10, 1942 in Clare with her predeceasing him on May 22, 2010. Cal was a graduate of Clare High School; he had served his Country during WWII in the Navy. Cal had worked for Michigan Bell in installation and repair for 46 years until his retirement.
