Catharina (Cathy) Muller went to be with her Lord and Savior on September 6, 2020 at 98 years old. Born on September 21, 1921 in Indonesia to Augustus Taulu and Maria Waney Taulu, she was one of seven children and the last surviving. She married Gerrit Jan Arends in 1940 and had one son, Gerrit J Arends. After losing her first husband, she married Jan T Muller on June 28, 1946 in Indonesia and had two children, Julia and Harry. The Mullers left Indonesia to live in the Netherlands for seven years. In 1957, they immigrated to California where they lived a full life. Both Cathy and Jan were longtime volunteers at Northridge Hospital and members and volunteers at Shepherd Church in Porter Ranch, Ca.

Cathy is preceded in death by her dear husband, Jan, son, Gerrit, son-in-law, Herbert Shilling, her parents and six siblings. Cathy is survived by her daughter, Julia Shilling of Clare, Mi., son, Harry (Bea) Muller of Palmdale, Ca., daughter-in-law, Sally Arends of Las Vegas, NV., 12 grandchildren, 20 great-grandchildren, and two great-great-grandchildren, 3 sisters-in-law and many nieces and nephews in Indonesia, Canada, and the Netherlands.
