Charles Glen Seymour went to be with Jesus on January 18, 2021. He died peacefully at his home after a short illness. He was born in Flint, Michigan on August 26, 1936, to Glenn and Jessie Seymour, both of them have preceded him in death.

Charles graduated from Utley School in Flint in 1954 and later completed a formal apprenticeship to become a machinist. He was employed at the General Motors plant in Bay City where he retired on January 1, 1991, after 22 years of Service. He had served for nine years with the Michigan National Guard.

He married Violet Molesworth on Sept. 21, 1957 and together they raised two sons. He loved spending time with his family as evidenced nearly every Sunday afternoon when the family joined together at 2409 West Herrick of family dinners.
