



Clifford T. Wellman

December 11, 1939 - June 23, 2016

Clifford Thomas Wellman, Sr., age 76 of Big Rapids, formerly of the Clare area, passed away at his home on Thursday, June 23, 2016. Clifford was born December 11, 1939 in Detroit, the son of Carl and Irene (Reynolds) Wellman. He was united in marriage to Frances Ann Nixon on August 22, 1964 at the St. Agatha Catholic Church in Detroit. They raised their family in Clare and became parishioners of St. Cecilia Catholic Church, now Our Lady of Hope Parish, St. Cecilia Site.

Clifford began his teaching career in Milford where he taught English and coached football and tennis. After five years he and his family moved to Capac where he taught another five years. He also coached baseball and football and taught Drivers Education. He and his family then moved to Clare where he finished his teaching and coaching career.

Clifford is survived by his wife, Frances, his four children Elizabeth (Jerry) Loyselle, Clifford Jr. (Michelle) Wellman, Robert (Danyelle Bylo) Wellman and Kathleen (Matthew) Merony; ten grandchildren, Jerry Jr. Loyselle, Matthew Loyselle, Clifford Thomas Wellman III, Kendall Wellman, Taylor Merony, Makayla Merony, Jenna Merony, Tyler Cremeans, Max Cremeans and Mya Cremeans; three sisters Yvonne O'Neil, Beverly Markulicz and Betty Johnson; one brother Raymond Wellman. Clifford was predeceased by his parents, four brothers, Robert, Neil, Louis and Donald and a sister Joanne Rothenstein.
