Daniel J. White, age 78, of Clare, passed away peacefully on Wednesday, August 20, 2025, at the North Woods Nursing Center in Farwell, surrounded by love and memories that spanned a lifetime. Born on February 27, 1947, in Clare to the late Erwin and Mary (Sutkey) White, Daniel lived a life marked by quiet strength, deep curiosity, and unwavering devotion to those he held dear.

He also leaves behind many nieces and nephews who will carry his memory forward. He was preceded in death by his brother Erwin White, Jr., and sisters Lois Meier, June White, and Pearl White.
