Dennis LeRoy Hawley, age 78 of Lake, passed away suddenly on Tuesday, November 12, 2024 at home. Dennis was born the son of Harold and Virginia (Clarke) Hawley on July 26, 1946 in Northampton, Massachusetts. He had served his Country in the U.S. Air Force during the Vietnam War. Dennis was united in marriage to Susan Lynn Pagano on November 16, 1968. 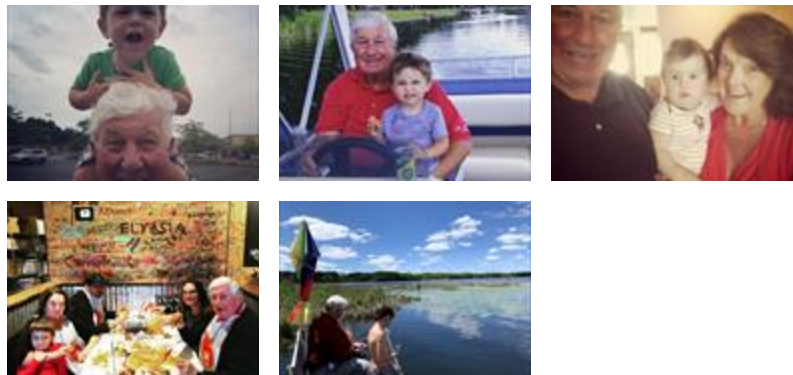
