



Dorothy Alice Wood

August 1, 1922 - October 21, 2016

Dorothy "Alice" Wood, age 94, of Clare, passed away peacefully on Friday, October 21, at Northwood's Nursing Center. She was born the daughter of Archie and Esther M. (Matthews) Trottier on Aug. 1, 1922, in Yakima, Washington. She married the love of her life, Clifford Wood on Nov. 15, 1942 in Torrence, California and he preceded her in death on Jan. 26, 1998. The wood's moved to Clare from Yakima in 1946 with baby Robert in tow. She was a member of the First Baptist Church in Clare, where she was a longtime active member of the King's Daughter organization. She had also been a longtime member of the Clare Rebekah Lodge. She loved to paint and sew, and had handmade hundreds of dresses for children in Haiti.

Survivors include; her sons, Robert (Terry) Wood of Beaverton, Timothy (Janet) Wood of Lake, Clifford (Becky) Wood of Farwell, daughters, Carol (Bob) Taylor of Clare, Mary (Rod) Mason of Farwell, and Diane (Dick Cook of Clare. Also surviving are 29 grandchildren, 56 great-grandchildren, 22 great-great grandchildren, two sisters-in-law, Shirley Miller of Clare, and Marye Miller of Rochester, and many nieces and nephews. Alice was preceded in death by her husband, Clifford, and two sons, Gerald and Richard.

Funeral services will be held on Wednesday, October 26, 2016 at 11:00 AM at the First Baptist Church of Clare with Pastor Doug Blackwell officiating. Burial will be in the Cherry Grove Cemetery.
