



Edward C. Weber

April 22, 1926 - April 25, 2015

Edward C. Weber, age 89 of Lake, passed away on Saturday, April 25, at Isabella County Medical Care Facility in Mt. Pleasant. He was born the son of Amos and Julia (Kruse) Weber on April 22, 1926, in Detroit. While attending Cass Tech High School, he enlisted in the US Navy and served on the USS Saratoga during WWII. After the war he returned to Detroit to finish his education and earned his degree in Engineering from Wayne State University in 1953. On September 2, 1950 he married the former Anna (Betty) Costello in Dearborn, and she survives him. Ed had worked for Ford Motor Company and left to work for the American Lutheran Church for a period of 11 years and returned to Ford Motor Co. and retired in 1991. Following his retirement, he and Betty moved permanently from Livonia to their summer home in Clare County. He taught CAD at CMU during his "retirement". He was a member of St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Reed City.

Survivors include, his wife, Betty, his children, Lynne Drexler of Ann Arbor, Lori Eldridge of Livonia, Susan (Rick) Curtis of Laingsburg and Eric (Deborah) Weber of Grass Lake, grandchildren, Brenna Eldridge, Zac and Joe Reilly, Scott (Melissa) Drexler and Erin Weber. Also surviving are his sister, Sally Gennette and his brothers, Carl and Dale. He was preceded in death by his parents and his sister Rosemary Miller.

Memorial services are to be held on Wednesday, April 29, at 11:00 AM at St. Paul's Lutheran Church, 22275 4 Mile Rd. Reed City, Michigan, 49677, with Pastor Dawn Pooley officiating. Interment will be in the Ft. Custer National
