



## Elden L. Green

May 20, 1942 - September 1, 2022

Elden Green, age 80, passed away peacefully on September 1, 2022 at Woodland Hospice in Mt Pleasant surrounded his by loved ones. He was born at home in Loomis MI on May 20th, 1942 to William Green and Irene Luella Faber. He worked in Lake George cutting pulp wood in the late 50's where he met his late wife Betty, so he married the bosses' daughter; they were united in marriage on February 13, 1960. Elden attended the Bader School, a one room schoolhouse, until he entered the Clare School system. Elden played Pony League baseball in his youth as a pitcher. He was a small business owner having owned a milk route in the 60's before big tankers came along. He could lift a milk can in each arm and hoist them onto his truck to deliver to Kraft in Clare. After selling the milk route, he briefly worked construction before his 30+ years driving chemicals from Dow Chemical with Coastal Tank Lines and Chemical Lehman in Midland. Elden loved racing, from drag racing in the 60's to stock cars in the 70's & 80's, many will remember Elden's signature green stock car "002" for many years. He enjoyed spending time with his family camping, snowmobiling and riding motorcycles. Elden was a well-respected "shade tree" mechanic who built and repaired cars for many folks in the area, another passion and skill he possessed.

Elden is survived by his son, Lee (Janet) Green of Kalkaska, daughter Leicia (Don Griffin) Romubio of Clare, brother Orval (Margaret) Hubel of Clare, sister in law Jean Hubel and Very Special friend Linda Showalter of Winn.
