Elmer B. Gingery, age 96 of Clare, passed away Monday, October 4, 2021 at his daughter's home in Lake. Elmer was born the son of the late Francis Bruce and Hattie (Warner) Gingery on February 22, 1925 in rural Gladwin County. He was a proud American who answered his Country's call, having served in the U.S. Navy during WWII as a fuel tanker guardsman stationed in the North Pacific.
