



Eugene L. "Pete" Taylor

September 6, 1933 - October 27, 2012

Eugene L. "Pete" Taylor, age 79, of Lake George, (formerly Highland and Grand Blanc) passed away peacefully at his home on Saturday, Oct. 27, 2012. He was born the son of William G. and Mae E. (Smeltzer) Taylor on Sept. 6, 1933 in Grand Blanc. He served in the US Army during the Korean War, and had been a supervisor with Pontiac Motor Company. He married the former Marion "Peggy Lee" Driscoll and she preceded him in death on Nov. 4, 2011. Pete and Peggy moved to Lake George from Highland in 1985. He had been a member of the Oakland County Classic Chevy Club, the Lake George Boosters Club, and the Good Sam Camping Club.

I will truly miss Pete and Peggy.

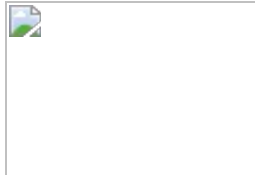
