Evelyn I. (Malcomnson) Breen, age 98 of Clare, passed away peacefully on Saturday, November 13, 2021 at the Pioneer Golden Estates Assisted Living Facility of Clare. On February 21, 1923, Evelyn was born one of five children to Donald and Lela (Woods) Malcomnson on their family farm in Harrison, MI. She was united in marriage to Oliver "Herb" Breen on March 5, 1942, in San Francisco, CA., and together the couple enjoyed seventy-one and a half years of marriage together until Herb's passing in October of 2013. Evelyn always managed to keep busy.
