Floyd Thomas Fair age 81 of Clare, passed away on Wednesday, August 18, 2021, at his home surrounded by his family. Floyd was born the son of the late Wayne Fair and Mildred (Siel) and Frank Walter of Clare on April 3, 1940. He lived his whole life in Clare, and graduated from Clare High School in 1957. 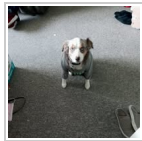
