



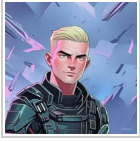
Gary S. Marcoux

November 5, 1946 - August 22, 2021

Gary S. "Boomer" Marcoux, age 74 of Lake, passed away unexpectedly on Sunday, August 22, 2021 at the MidMichigan Medical Center of Clare. On November 5, 1946, Gary was born one of three sons to Russell and Carla (Pratt) Marcoux in Saginaw, MI. Shortly after his graduation from Saginaw High in 1965, Gary enlisted with the U.S. Marine Corps, and he very proudly served from 1968 to 1970, stationed at both Camp Pendleton and actively deployed in Vietnam. He also proudly worked at the American Legion Post #439 of Saginaw after his military career had ended. Gary loved his family, and he loved helping people. He greatly enjoyed the outdoors, especially when he could travel the country to feed his passion for the U.S.'s rich historical sites. Gary also loved his time spent traveling as a carry in his later years. He had a great love of all animals, but none more than his cat Garfield. Gary is survived by his beloved daughter Amanda M. Sayers (Zachary Walser) of Freeland, and his brothers Grant (Vickie) Marcoux of Lake and Guy (Pam) Marcoux of Saginaw. Other survivors include his special niece Tonya Marcoux of Saginaw, his caregiver Rosalind Randolph of Lake, and numerous nieces and nephews.
