Georgina Ann Johnson, age 65 of Clare, passed away unexpectedly on November 6, 2020 at her home. 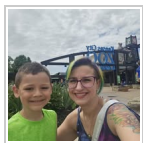

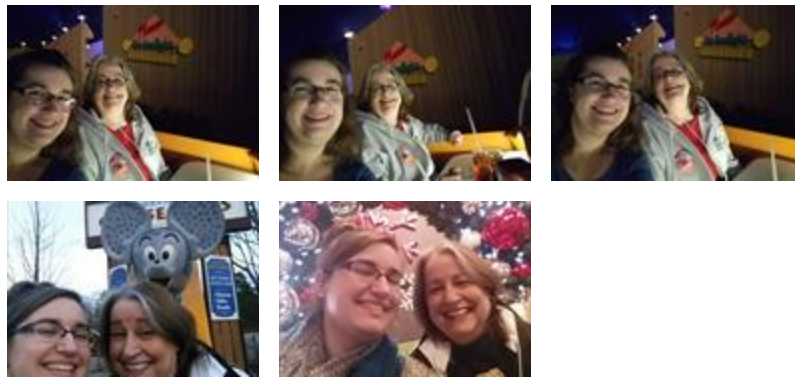

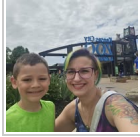
