Gertrude F. (Hess) Wolfe, 86, passed away on Sunday, August 17, 2014. Gertrude was born in Clare on May 27, 1928, the daughter of Walter and Dora (Haring) Hess. She grew up there in the original homestead log house along with her older brothers and sister and completed the 8th grade at Brewer School (a one room schoolhouse).

Overcoming physical challenges Gertrude worked full-time at the Midland Hospital for 40 years, the last 25 in the Nursing Office. She was a loving mother, devoted caregiver to her mother and grandparents and a steadfast friend to many. Gertrude's hands were never idle, among several interests she was an accomplished quilter, knitter, weaver and basket maker. She had a love for nature and spent many hours watching birds and wildlife in her yard that she landscaped purposefully for this reason. Gertrude loved her dogs whose constant presence provided companionship and loyalty.
