Glen L. Gunderman passed into the presence of his Savior on Wednesday, June 14, 2023. Glen was born in Isabella County on October 23, 1929, to Kenneth E. and Naola M. (Archbold) Gunderman. 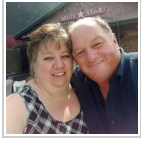
