Glenn Robert Ohler, age 63, of Eugene, Oregon, passed away Saturday, March 1, 2025 at the Oregon Health and Science University. In 2006 he became a fireman for the Santa Barbara County Fire Department. Glenn spent hours at the beach creating amazing sand art, using a rake and a pole to make the drawings.
