



## Glenn H. Stephens

September 9, 1948 - March 29, 2014

Glenn H. Stephens, age 65, of Farwell, passed away peacefully at his home on Saturday, March 29, surrounded by family and friends. He was born the son of James and Evelyn (Steffler) Stephens on September 9, 1948, in Detroit. He married Teresa VanOstran and she survives him. Glenn was a Computer Technician, specializing in computer installation and repair. He moved to White Birch Lakes near Farwell in 2010 from the Detroit area.
