



Harry "Dale" Linton

December 15, 1947 - September 26, 2015

Harry "Dale" Linton Jr., age 67, of Farwell, went home to be with the Lord on Saturday, September 26, 2015. He was born the son of Harry and Edna (Harrington) Linton Sr. on December 15, 1947 in Midland, Michigan. Dale proudly served in the US Army during Vietnam and passionately displayed his patriotism. Along with his patriotism, Dale was passionate about many things, including; his service as a board member and greeter at the Clare Assembly of God Church, where he is a member, hunting and fishing, being outdoors on his tractor, and especially watching his grandchildren's sporting events. Dale married Karen Crowder on October 18, 1969 and she survives him. He worked as pipefitter for Dow Chemical the majority of his working years. Dale's survivors include his wife, Karen, his children, Kim (Howard) Scott of Farwell, Kelly (Corey) Edmonds of Beaverton, and Jeff (Christina) Linton of Farwell. Also surviving Dale is his mother Edna Janderwski of Clare, his grandchildren, Taylor and Tiffany Edmonds, Kourtnee Scott, Calvin and ColeLee Linton, his brothers, Larry (Bev) Linton, Floyd (Aida) Linton, Harold (Kordell) Rauschenberger, and his sister Nancy (Lonnie) Johnson.
