Henry "Hank" W. Pode, age 86 of Lake, passed away Tuesday, October 2, 2012. Hank was born the son of Heinrich and Alexandra (Ryzincynski) Pode on July 18, 1926 in Detroit. He was united in marriage to Theresa Raveau on November 29, 1947. Hank had served his Country in the Army during WWII; returning home he began his career as a carpenter.
