September 2, 1913 - August 6, 2014

Homer W. House age 100 years passed away Wednesday, August 6, 2014 at Northwoods Nursing Center in Farwell, holding his wife's hand. He was born September 2, 1913 in Rosebush to the late George S. and Rose (Schug) House. Homer received a BS from what is now CMU and did post graduate work at U of M to become a CPA. Homer's varied work experience included public accountant, dairy farmer, owner of House Oil Company (Zephyr filling station), among other things. Homer loved to travel, including several trips to Canada, Alaska, and the western United States both with his wife, and on hunting or fishing trips.

Homer is survived by his wife Janet (Pearce) of 69 years, 5 children: Calla, James Roger (Sandra), Roxanne (Jim), Valerie (Richard), Julie (Mark), 13 grandchildren, and 18 great-grandchildren.
