Irene J. (Balint) Sheredy, age 96 of Clare, passed away peacefully on Saturday, May 15, 2021 at her home. On August 1, 1924, Irene was born one of seven children to Emery and Anna (Chirip) Balint in Chicago, IL. Shortly after her birth, Irene's family relocated to the Central Michigan area, where she has been a lifelong resident. After her graduation from Mt. Pleasant High School, Irene started a brief work career with the Ferro Stamping Company of Mt. Pleasant. While working at the stamping factory, Irene was introduced to Albert Sheredy and not long after, the pair was united in marriage on November 1, 1948 at the Sacred Heart Catholic Church of Mt. Pleasant. Together the couple enjoyed nearly thirty-six years of marriage together until Albert's passing in 1984. Irene became a proud member of the St. Cecilia Catholic Church after she and Albert moved to Clare, and she served as a member of the Ladies' Guild. Her other passions included her love for being outdoors to tend to her flower gardens and yard work, following the current political events, watching golf (especially Tiger Wood's), and of course playing her daily scratch off tickets. But those that knew Irene best knew that her greatest passion and pride in her life was her caretaker role she served for her handicapped son David.

Irene is survived by her sister Margaret Serviss of Harrison, her several cherished nieces and nephews, and her sisters-in-law Fran Bolle, Kate Sheredy, and Pat Sheredy. Irene was preceded in death by her husband Albert Sheredy, her infant son Alan Sheredy and her adult son David Sheredy,

her parents Emery and Anna Balint, and her siblings Jimmy Balint, Christine Kramer, Anna Luce, Theresa Niewiadomski, and Veronica Daley.

In keeping with Irene's wishes, cremation has taken place. Her final place of rest will be with her family in the St. Cecilia Catholic Cemetery of Clare.
