Jack H. Boyer, age 87, of Farwell, passed away peacefully at his home on Tuesday, Feb. 9, 2021. Jack was born the son of Ray and Agnes (Whitney) Boyer on Dec. 23, 1933, in Gladwin. Jack served in the US Army just after the Korean War. He had worked as a foreman for the Laborers and the Teamsters, and had retired from Valley Mechanical Contracting.
