Jack L. Haring, age 80 of Clare, passed away Friday, March 10, 2023 at the MyMichigan Medical Center in Midland following a valiant fight against his extended illness with his family at his side. He was a Heavy Equipment Operator with the Operating Engineers Local 324 and was a member of the union for 55 years.
