Jack G. Hemstreet, age 93, of Clare, passed away on Wednesday, Dec. 23, at Medilodge of Clare. Jack was born the son of George and Mary (Gerow) Hemstreet on Dec. 13, 1927 in Sheridan Twp. of Clare County. He had married Romagne Perry on April 20, 1946 and she preceded him in death on Jan. 15, 2017. Jack had retired from Consumer's Energy as a Gas Executive. He had lived his entire life in the Clare Area and had attended the Clare Congregational Church when he was younger. Jack had golfed with the Monday Night Men's League at Twin Elm's (Now Firefly Golf Links) . He loved his horses.
