Jack W. Mann, Sr., age 80 of Flint, passed away unexpectedly on Wednesday, May 25, 2016 at his home in Flint. Jack was born the son of Wilbur and Ilo (Athey) Mann on January 3, 1936 in Gladwin. 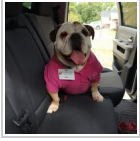
