



## James A. Mayer Sr.

June 23, 1934 - February 12, 2017

James A. Mayer, Sr., age 82 of Harrison, passed away peacefully with his family by his side at the Aleda E. Lutz VA Medical Facility in Saginaw, MI. on Sunday, February 12, 2017. James was born the son of Austin and Mazie (Crum) Mayer on June 23, 1934 in Lansing, Mi. He was a very proud member of the United States Armed Forces having served for the U.S. Navy during the Korean Era, and later serving for the U.S. Army during the Vietnam Era eventually obtaining the rank of Sergeant E7. After retiring from the military, James enjoyed working locally as a deputy for the Clare County Sherriff Department and as a gun clerk at Jay's Sporting Goods, which was one of his favorite passions.

James is survived by his five children Paul (J. Elaine) Mayer of Ft. Myers, FL., James A. Mayer II of Harrison, Teresa (Mike) Wilcox of Alabama, Stacie (Scott) Myers of N.Y., and Kevin (Jennifer) Mayer of Coleman. He is also survived by his brother Edgar (Lois) Mayer of Mt.
