Jan R. Altman, age 67, of Weidman, passed away on Sunday Feb. 7, at his home. He was born the son of Robert H. and Betty Jane (Baldwin) Altman on July 22, 1948 in Midland. He married Lynda Brokaw and she survives him. He served multiple tours of duty with the 101st Airborne Division, US Army during the Vietnam war. He later taught Survivor Skills in Panama. He was a distinguished Marksman and had qualified for and competed in the Panama Games. Jan had served his local communities as a Police Officer with Harrison Police Dept., Pinconning Police Dept., Coleman Police Dept., and had recently retired as the Isabella County Animal Control officer. He was also a member of the DAV, and the NRA.
