



## Janet M. Huntoon

Janet M. Huntoon, age 77 of Lansing, formerly of Clare, passed away peacefully at her home on Wednesday, May 18, 2022. On July 15, 1944, Janet was born the daughter of Walter and Ruth (England) Green in Flint, MI. Although she was born in Flint, Janet did not live there long, as she moved to the Clare area in her early childhood with her family where she lived through her school years and years where she raised a family of her own. Seeking a change of scenery in the 1980's Janet moved to Las Vegas, NV, where an opportunity in the casino industry began and led to an impressive thirty-plus year career where at one point or another Janet worked about every single area on a given casino floor starting in the Nevada Palace Casino before serving much of her career at the Eastside Cannery Hotel and Casino. 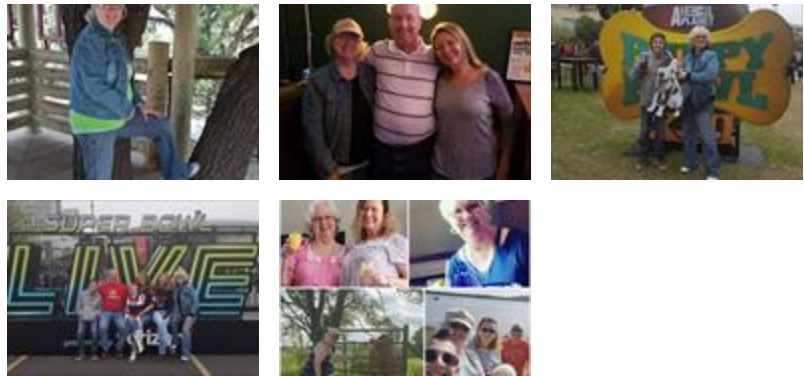

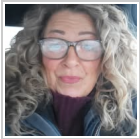
