Jeffrey Mark Tice, age 53 of Clare, passed away unexpectedly on Wednesday, December 6, 2023 in Loomis. He was born the son of Daniel and Marcia Ann (Deurson) Tice on August 26, 1970, in Flint, MI. Jeffrey's younger years were spent in Clio, until he moved to the Loomis area in the early 1990's. During his working years, Jeffrey was a carpenter, working largely with Ed Miller at Best Built Pole Barns. Jeffrey's passions included riding snowmobiles, fishing, and playing games of dice and darts with friends and family. Jeff was a socialite and had a notorious reputation as a "gentle Giant". He was a big fan of Detroit Lions Football and Wrestling.

Jeffrey is survived by his three children Frederick Rosencrants of Flint, Daniel Harley Tice of Farwell and Dania Benjamin of Loomis, his father Dan Tice of Loomis, and his brothers Richard Tice of Loomis and James Tice of Clare. Other survivors include his seven grandchildren Addalyn, Briella, Axavier, Blayden, Skyler, Charlotte, and Riley and his former spouse Tanya Benjamin. He was preceded in death by his mother Marcia Tice.

In keeping with Jeffrey's wishes, cremation has taken place. A Memorial Service will be held at the New Hope Fellowship Missionary Church in Loomis on Saturday, January 13, 2024 at 2 P.M. A private graveside service will take place in the Wise Township Cemetery, where Jeff will be laid to rest with other members of the Tice family on a date yet to be determined.
