Jeremy A. Caldwell, age 35 of Clare, passed away from injuries sustained in an automobile accident on Sunday, January 27, 2013. Jeremy was born May 9, 1977, in Trenton. Jeremy had lived in the Central Michigan area since moving from Brownstown in 1990. He had worked as a cook at Mountaintown Station as well as working weekends during the summer at Chippewa River Outfitters. Jeremy was an avid hunter and fisherman; he loved his dogs and spending time outdoors. He will be deeply missed by his family and friends.
