John T. Morgan, age 87 of Farwell, passed away peacefully on Monday, September 2, 2024 at the MyMichigan Medical Center of Midland. On October 5, 1936, John was born one of nine children to Roy and Dorothy (Grimes) Morgan in Gilmore, Arkansas. John lived his childhood and young adulthood in Arkansas, where he helped his family farm, before moving to Chicago seeking a different career.
