Jordon Lockmiller, age 87 of Lake, passed away Saturday, January 12, 2019 at his home. Jordon was born the son of Edward and Eve (Allen) Lockmiller on November 13, 1931 in Monroe. He was united in marriage to Joan E. Jacobs on June 28, 1952 with her preceding him in death on October 24, 2018. He served in the U.S. Air Force as a Crew Chief on the B-47 Bomber during the Korean War. He was stationed at Lake Charles Air Force Base in Louisiana and was discharged on November 29, 1954. He worked at the River Raisin/Union Camp Paper Company for over 30 years. He resided in Monroe where he and Joan raised their four children. Together they moved to Lake where Jordon became very active in the community, serving on many local and state committees and boards; he had also served as a Clare County Commissioner for eight years. Jordon was also a member of the Clare Farwell American Legion and a lifetime member of the B-47 Stratojet Association. He was a people person and knew someone wherever he went; he loved to sing and was known for his off color jokes. He will be fondly remembered by his family and friends.

Survivors include his children Janet M. Anthony, Debra (Jess) Linenkugel and Scott Lockmiller; his grandchildren David (Angela), Joseph (Julie), Gregory (Sarah) and Jenae; 10 great grandchildren.
