Joseph F. Saraino, age 76, of Harrison, (formerly of Warren), passed away on Tuesday, April 12, 2016, at his home. He was born the son of Gaetano and Marion (Tundo) Saraino on May 5, 1939 in Detroit. He had served in the US Marine Corps during the Korean War and had retired from the City of Warren Dept. of Public Works. He moved to Harrison from Warren in 1999. Joseph was a member of the American Legion, Moose, and VFW, and Fraternal Order of Eagles, all in Harrison, and enjoyed fishing, feeding birds and tormenting the squirrels that visited his bird feeders.

Survivors include his siblings, Constance Canute of Gettysburg, Md., Benito Saraino of Clare, Mary Hult of Sterling Hgts., and Michael Saraino of Harrison Twp., Michigan, and several nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his sisters, Florence Herrmann and Carmella Saraino.

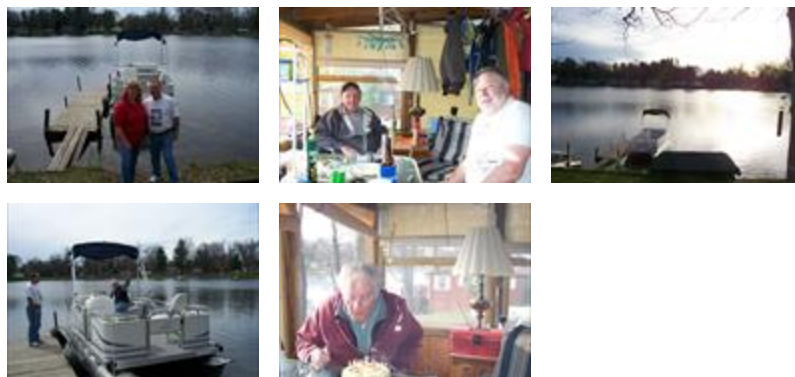
