Julie G. Moore, age 59, of Clare, passed away suddenly on Sunday, August 26, 2018, in Pigeon, Michigan. She was born the daughter of Jerry and Joan (Schmidt) Williams on July 16, 1959 in Saginaw. Her teenage years were spent largely in Coleman. On Oct. 22, 1977 she married Scott Moore. A lifelong resident of the Central Michigan area, they have made their home in Clare for the past 32 years. Julie had recently retired from Wendy's Restaurant in Clare after over 20 years of employment. She was a creative girl, who will be remembered for her skill as a seamstress and creator of jewelry and handbags. She had designed and even built her own Kitchen Cabinetry, but above all of her "likes", her family was always first priority. 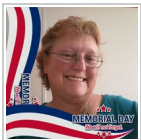
