June Marie Creguer (née Thompson, Berg) passed away peacefully, with her compassionate caregivers at her side, at the Isabella County Medical Care Facility on April 11, 2020, at the age of 86.

June was born on October 5, 1933, to LG and Nina Thompson (née Colmus), the eldest of five children. A lifelong resident of Clare, Michigan, “Junie” was best known for her glowing smile and quick wit. She made innumerable, lifelong friends throughout her years of work at the Doherty Hotel, Mill End, and Lone Pine, among others. She loved music (which she lovingly instilled in her children), sewing, and playing cards. She was an amazing cook, even though she always said it wasn’t “fancy,” and she will forever be remembered for making the world’s best meatloaf and homemade breads. 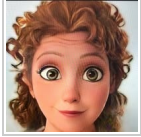
