June E. (Mitchell) Foell, age 92 of Clare, passed away peacefully on Saturday, June 26, 2021 surrounded by her family. On June 29, 1928, June was born the daughter of Maurice and Dora (Zeis) Mitchell in Lansing, MI. She was united in marriage to Gordon A. “Corky” Foell on August 26, 1949 in Clare, MI. and the pair enjoyed fifty-two years of marriage together until the time of Corky’s passing in February of 2002. Shortly after June’s graduation from Lansing Eastern High School, June’s family moved their photography business to Clare, where June eventually met Corky, and established her roots for her remaining years. Her working career began briefly with Clare’s Holley Carburetor shop, then as equally briefly she cleaned homes professionally, before she began her over twenty-year career working as Dr. Ballard’s office nurse and manager in Clare.
