Kenneth A. Warner Sr., age 79, of Clare, passed away peacefully on Monday, Oct. 21, 2019, at his home with family at his side. He was born the son of Henry and Dorothy (Foor) Warner Jr. on Nov. 9, 1939, in Saginaw. Ken lived in the Mid-Michigan area for all of his life. He graduated from Marion High School and later moved to Clare where he farmed and raised livestock for the rest of his life. Ken married Loretta Hess, his wife of 58 years.
