Larry W. Everts, age 83, died on Sunday, February 24, 2019 in Traverse City, MI. He was born in Lansing to Howard and Emma Everts and was the second of three children.

Larry was an avid fisherman and hunter his entire life. As a lover of music, he played the saxophone in the Clare High School band. In 1958, he served in the military as chaplain assistant and was honorably discharged.
